1.) Draw a dot in the middle of your paper.
2.) Draw 4 lines that go through the dot to the edges of the paper. Very, very lightly with your pencil, number the sections 1-8.

3.) Draw 3 curved lines in one of the sections.
4.) In the next section, draw 3 curved lines that connect to the other lines, but curve the OPPOSITE way.

5.) Repeat this for each section, making sure the lines curve in opposite directions.

6.) With marker, color every other curved section in sections 2, 4, 6 and 8 with one WARM color.
7.) With marker, color every other curved section in sections $1,3,5$ and 7 with one COOL color. The colored sections should be opposite, so one marker section should not touch another marker section.

8.) In all remaining sections, shade the empty curved sections with a COLORED PENCIL that is the SAME COLOR as the section. Make each section darker at the edges and lighter in the middle.
